11:00am Narrative Guided Tour

Keith Crysler will provide a unique look at the Historic Gardens, concentrating on the heritage features and theming of Canada's 2015 Garden of the Year.

2:00pm-4:00pm Music in the Gardens

Enjoy local music and fun under the shade of our giant weeping elm as you sip on a coffee or lemonade from the Elm Tree Cafe.

In the Community:

Fort Anne National Historic Site: Check out the major makeover at Fort Anne, with incredible new displays and activities. Fort Anne is celebrating the centennial of their designation in 1917 as Canada's first National Historic Site.

Port Royal National Historic Site: Port Royal is also celebrating the centennial of Canada's National Historic Sites, and is a highlight of any visit.

ArtsPlace: Special Canada 150 Exhibit "Fundy Art". A display of the art the sea has inspired over the years.

O'Dell House Museum: Special Canada 150 Exhibit "Fundy Boats". A glimpse at the boats 'born' in the Annapolis Region - boats working here and dying here.

"Lookabout" - a collaborative exhibit by artist Jennifer Angus involves installations at the Historic Gardens, ARTsPLACE, Sissiboo Coffee Roaster, King's Theatre and O'Dell House Museum. Be sure to pick up your special passport from any of these locations.

Browse our shops, dine in one of our cafes, stroll the boardwalk and check out the new waterfront amphitheatre, visit our museums. In the evening, take part in Alan Melanson's Candlelight Graveyard Tour, or catch a show at King's Theatre.
